



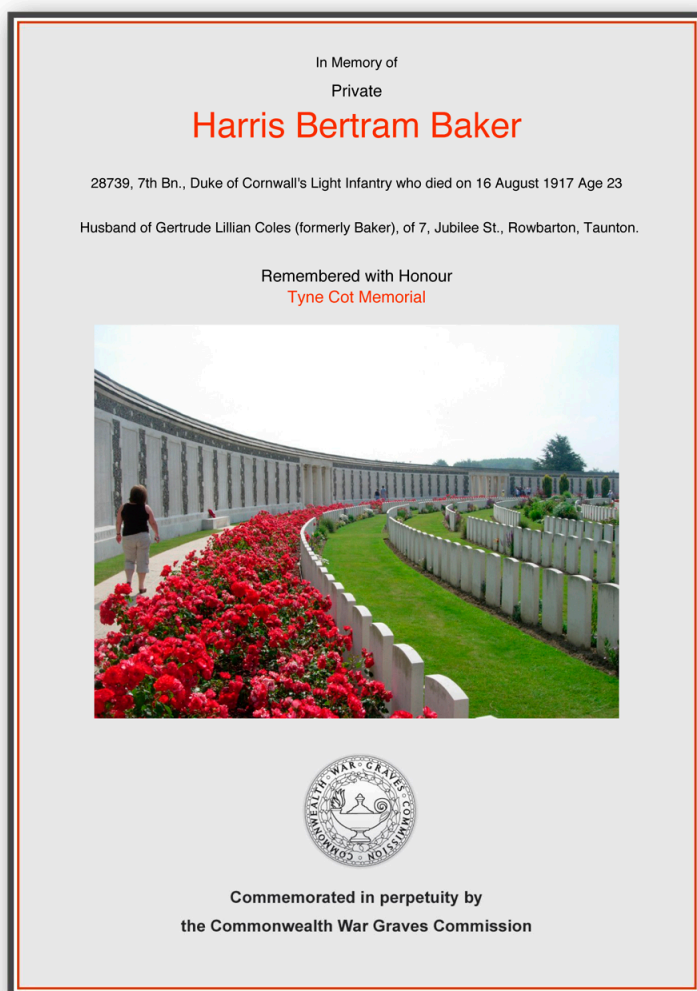
Harris Bertram Baker

1895 - 1917

Harris Bertram Baker was born in Winsford in 1895, the son of John, a stonemason and Sarah Baker and married Gertrude Duddridge of Taunton.

Harris served in the West Somerset Yeomanry and subsequently in the 7th Bn. Duke of Cornwall's Light Infantry from 1916 to 1917 in France and Flanders.

He died on the 16th August 1917 age 23, killed in action in the Battle of Langemark, part of the Third Battle of Ypres.



Harris is Remembered with Honour at the Tyne Cot Memorial in Belgium

A particularly tragic week for Winsford as Archie Callaway was also killed in the same battle.
