



Archibald Callaway

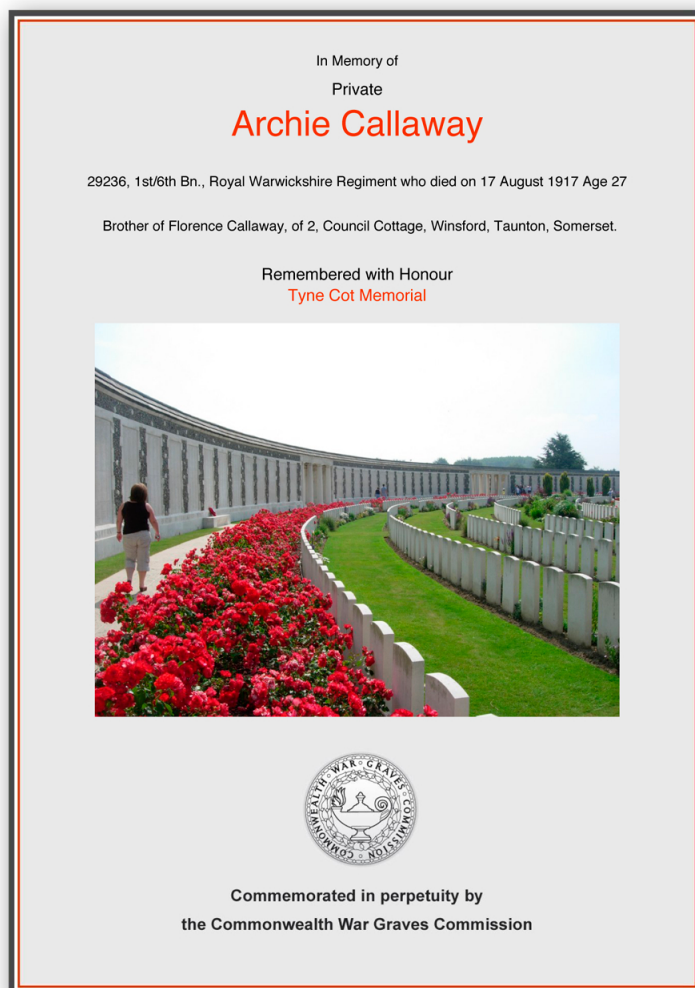
1891 - 1917

Archibald Callaway was born in 1891 the youngest of six children of Thomas and Elizabeth Callaway and the younger brother of Frederick; they were all born in Winsford.

Prior to WW1 he worked as a carter on a local farm.

He served as a Private, first in the Somerset Light Infantry and then in the 1st/6th Battalion, Royal Warwickshire Regiment.

He was killed in action at the battle of Langemark, part of the Third Battle of Ypres on the 17th August 1917 aged 27.



Archie, like his brother Frederick, is Remembered with Honour at the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium and in Winsford Church.

Harris Baker, also of Winsford fought and was killed in the same battle.
