



Eustace Fletcher Moyes

1889 - 1955

Eustace Fletcher Moyes was born in 1889, the son of Rev. W B and Clara Moyes and younger brother of Wilfrid (below). He was educated at Uppingham School, Rutland.

Eustace enlisted with the Royal Naval Air Service and on the 12th November 1914 was promoted to Flight Sub Lieutenant. In January 1916 he was further promoted to Flight Lieutenant. He served throughout the War ending his service as a Flight Commander involved with Airships.

He married Vera Phillipson in London in 1927. Eustace died in Jersey in 1955.

He was the father of Bridget Ryle who lives in Winsford.

Wilfrid Blake Moyes MM

1888 - 1918

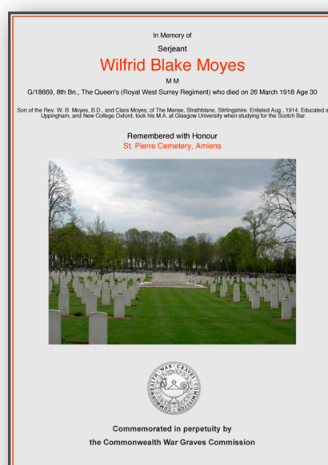
Wilfrid Blake Moyes was born in 1888, the son of the Rev. W B and Clara Moyes of Strathbane, Stirlingshire.

He was educated at Uppingham School, Rutland and New College, Oxford. He took his M.A. at Glasgow University when studying for the Scottish Bar.

Wilfrid enlisted in August 1914 with the 10711 Battalion, Highland Light Infantry and later moved Regiment becoming a Sergeant with the 8th Battalion, Queens (Royal West Surrey Regiment) - sometimes known as the Mutton Lancers after their 'Lamb and Flag' cap badge.

Wilfrid was killed in action on the 26th March 1918 age 30 and is Remembered with Honour at the St Pierre Cemetery, Amiens, Somme, France.

He is uncle to Bridget Ryle of Winsford.
