



James Newton

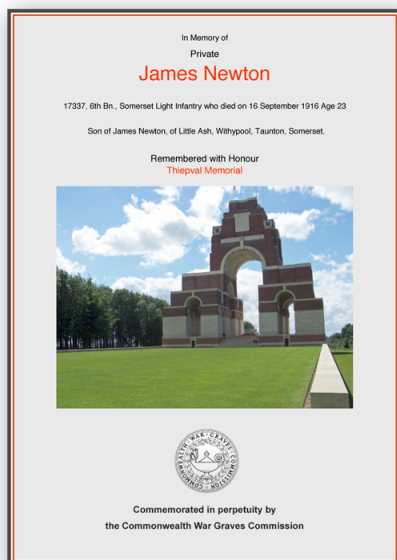
1895 - 1916

James Newton was born in the Parish of Winsford in 1895, the son of James and Mary Newton of Little Ash.

He served as a Private with the 6th Battalion, the Somerset Light Infantry.

James was killed in action on the 16th September 1916 in the Battle of Bernafay Wood, a continuation of the Battle of Delville Wood in the Second Phase of the Battle of the Somme.

Sadly he died just a week after James Blake also of Winsford. Again, a great loss for the village.



James is Remembered with Honour at the Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France and in Winsford Church.

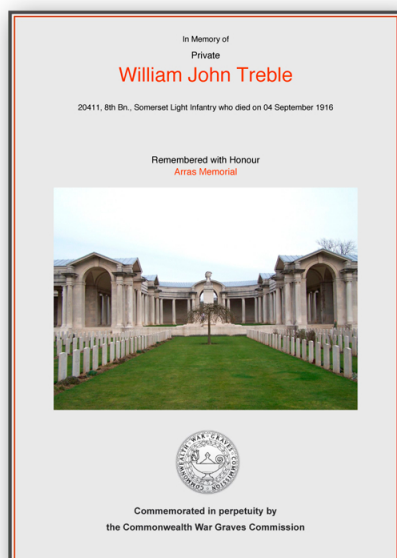


William John Treble

1897 - 1916

William John Treble was born in High Bray, Devon in 1897, the son of William James Treble, a carpenter and Alice Susan of Miltons Cottage (then Winsford now Bridgetown).

William served as a Private in the 8th Battalion, Somerset Light Infantry and saw action in the Second Phase of the Battle of the Somme.



William was killed in action on the 4th September 1916 and is Remembered with Honour at the Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais, France and in Winsford Church.
