

## Eric Frederick Wilton

1895 - 1964

Eric Frederick Wilton was born on the 9th April 1895, the youngest child of Sir Thomas and Lady Wilton. He lived in Dartmouth and was educated at Blundells School in Tiverton. He married Christine O J Sieill Turner in February 1922.

Eric had wanted to join the Army but was sent away because he was too young, he subsequently went to join the RAF, lying about his age.

Before the outbreak of war and because he was very keen on horses he joined the Royal Horse Artillery and spent much of the war in India, leaving the Army as a Major. Eric died in 1964





He was the father of Roseanne Hoare, late of Winsford.



## Fernand Jean Cayrol Croix de Guerre

1887 - 1939

Fernand Jean-Baptiste Cayrol was born in Paris in 1887 and from then little is known of him untill he appears in the 1911 Census as living in England.

He fought for the French in World War 1 and was awarded the honour of the Croix de Guerre with the addition of two stars.

He later married in England and is the grandfather of Wavell Urry of Farm, Winsford
